



Legacy Vendor Award

The purpose is to establish a perpetual award that recognizes individual Vendor Members for their service to the Maintenance Superintendents Association for a minimum of 15 years.

NOMINATIONS

Nomination of vendor member shall be per the following established requirements.

1. A member who has demonstrated the ability to lead his/her Chapters towards recognition of the organization as a leader in sound practices of Public Works.
2. A member who has contributed to or participated in the development of new concepts that have or are benefitting the organization.
3. A member who strived to be fair with all whom he directed or dealt with and did not discriminate among them on the basis of race, color, sex, creed, social class, or ethnic background.
4. A member who was sensitive to the reactions of associates and responded accordingly.
5. A member who maintained a high degree of self-control under difficult circumstances.
6. A member who possessed a high degree of loyalty, truthfulness, and honesty.
7. Member may be living or deceased.
8. Retired members shall be considered, as long as they were members in good standing at the time of retirement.

Approved nomination form must be received by the Executive Board Secretary no later than April 1st. Secretary will distribute to each member of the Executive Board and Three B Enterprises.

VOTING AND SELECTION PROCESS

A chapter may nominate up to three (3) individuals per year. The Executive Board may approve no more than 12 nominations in one year.

The Executive Board President shall present the approved names of all qualified nominees at the annual May Executive Board meeting to be voted on by each voting member of the Executive Board, including alternate vendor representatives. Vote shall consist of 50% plus written yea/no ballot vote by voting members to approve nominee.

Chapter delegates are encouraged to vote on the body of work of the individual, and not to consider how many other nominees are from that Chapter. If there are more than 12 nominations, only the top 12 vote getters shall receive awards. In the case of a tie for “12th” place, numbers of years’ service to the MSA shall serve as the tiebreaker.

PREPARATION AND PRESENTATION OF AWARD

The President’s designee shall purchase and prepare for presentation of a nominee’s name imprinted on a 1.5” X 3” plate to be mounted on the perpetual award that will be displayed at Vendor Hospitality night of the annual Conference. Plate shall be black with Silver lettering 1” tall. The perpetual award will be made of wood measuring 18” X 30”.

An individual plaque commemorating the nomination shall also be presented to each nominee.
